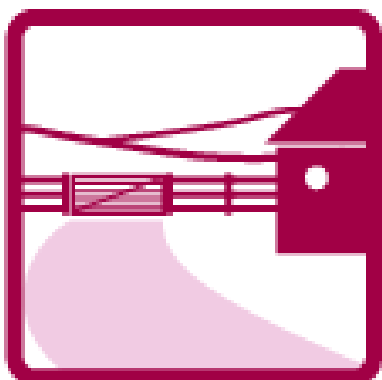


# Fam 30

## Iodophor disinfectant



### Description

### How to Use

#### GENERAL SANITISING – LIVESTOCK HOUSING:

Adjust dilution to suit soil level and/or disease history of livestock housing i.e. between 1 part FAM 30 to between 100 & 550 parts of water. May also be used to treat buckets, cages, hatchery trays, drinkers, crates & other non-porous surfaces.

#### GENERAL SANITISING - FISHERIES: FISH NETS, HOLDING TANKS & CRATES

Use at a dilution of 1:100 to prevent the spread of disease in ponds & fisheries.

#### WHEEL AND FOOT BATHS:

To help prevent the spread of disease, dilute 1:90 with water & renew daily if heavily soiled.

#### AERIAL DISINFECTION:

Apply at a suitable rate through a mist generator.

#### DRINKING WATER SYSTEMS:

Used as a sanitising aid, dilute one part FAM 30 with 2,500 parts of water. Allow contact time of 30 minutes before rinsing with clean water.

#### DISEASE CONTROL ORDERS:

DEFRA approved against **Foot & Mouth disease** at 1:550, **Swine Vesicular disease** at 1:100, **Diseases of Poultry** 1:100, **Tuberculosis** at 1:20 & for general use at 1:90. Recommended for use against **Blue Ear Pig Disease (PRRS)** at 1:200.
